\* \* Please do not send in chips, sweets, or sugary juices. Your child will not be allowed to eat these items for snack. Mid-morning snacks must be healthy.


Note: Your child will be supplied with an agenda book on the first day of school. All students are required to use this agenda book to record their daily homework assignments.
